



Assessment Schedule 2021-2022

As a public charter school, Midlands Middle College participates in all state-mandated assessments, curriculum-based final exams, as well as assessments designed to measure students' college and career readiness. Below is the tentative schedule for the 2021-2022 school year.

End-of-Course (EOC) Examination Program

Students enrolled in Algebra 1, English 2, Biology 1 and/or US History must take the End-of-Course Exam, [which counts 20% of the final course grade](#).

Fall Semester: December 16 @ 9:00 AM

Spring Semester: May 26 @ 9:00 AM

PSAT

The PSAT/NMSQT focuses on the skills and knowledge students learn in high school and need to succeed in college. This test is optional but is recommended for all 3rd-year students.

October 29 @ 9:00 AM

College Entrance Exams

All students in their 3rd year of high school may choose to take either the ACT or the SAT once for free. This is optional but highly recommended.

ACT: March 8 @ 9:00 AM

SAT: April 26 @ 9:00 AM

Career Readiness Assessment

All students in their 3rd year of high school must take the WIN Ready to Work (R2W) and Essential Soft Skills (ESS) Assessments. Students may earn a career credential for skill mastery.

March 30 @ 9:00 AM

Seniors new to MMC who did not take the WIN assessment last spring must take the assessment this fall.

October 27 @ 9:00 AM

English Language Proficiency Assessment

Any student who is determined to have limited English proficiency must take ACCESS for ELLs® each spring until meeting state requirements for English proficiency.

February 9 @ 9:00 AM

Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery

MMC encourages all students to take the ASVAB each year. This assessment measures your knowledge and ability in ten different areas, and identifies which jobs you are best suited to perform.

Midlands Technical College Placement Test

MMC offers the Accuplacer to all students. This test determines which dual-enrollment courses a student is eligible to take.

VirtualSC course exams will be given and proctored at MMC.

MMC Final Exams

All courses at MMC will end with a final exam in the last week of the semester. Any student may exempt the exam if he/she has a final course average of 80 or above. Graduating seniors are exempt from each MMC spring semester exam with a passing grade in the course. Exemptions do not apply to MTC, VirtualSC or EOC courses. Any student with an exemption may choose to take the exam to earn a higher course grade.
