| Principals Update | Mr. Robinson summarized the state report card rating along with a detailed explanation of the report card score metrics. |
| Finance and Enrollment Summary | Mr. Robinson explained in detail the finances, payroll, and enrollment figures. The overall financial statement is in good shape. In the future, the board would like to see budget-to-actuals broken down in the financial statements. |
| Enrollment Update | Currently, enrollment is at 101 students. 81 dual enrollment classes are being taken in partnership with MTC. |
